## Superior Court Getting People On-Line and Out of Line

San Diegans Can  
Now Schedule Some  
Appointments On-Line

Moving through San Diego's Family Law Court has just gotten a little easier. San Diegans seeking help from the Superior Court's Family Law Facilitators (FLF) Office can now book and reschedule appointments for FLF workshops on-line at [www.sdcourt.ca.gov](http://www.sdcourt.ca.gov). In the past, these activities would need to be done in person. The on-line service involves FLF workshops on Modifications of Child Custody/Visitation Orders and Modifications of Child Support Orders.

"We are pleased to offer this new service. It will save people a trip to the courthouse, time standing in line, and will assist them in preparing for the workshops. This is also another step forward in our effort to offer more court services on-line so people can save time and

money,” says Executive Officer, Michael Roddy.

The Family Law Facilitator's Office is available to help unrepresented parents and parties who have questions about family law issues. They can help individuals prepare court forms and can give general legal information. The FLF Office is staffed by court attorneys, paralegals, and clerks with experience in family law. The Family Law Facilitator's Office does not assist parents or parties who are represented by an attorney. The attorneys at the Family Law Facilitator's Office are neutral court employees who do not represent any parent or party and may provide information and services to all parties in the case.

The new on-line scheduling program will also help people save money and time by allowing them to download, free of charge, forms they will need for the workshops; and if someone's schedule changes, they can quickly cancel and reschedule appointments.

## CIVIL LITIGATION SECTION MEETING RECAP

On August 18, 2010, Jon H. Epstein and Mark R. Raftery presented a program entitled "So, You Settled Your Case. Now What?" This program was the first Foothills Bar section program to be video taped and presented a lively discussion about techniques to better protect your clients, and yourself, when settling a case. They also discussed practical points to consider when putting your settlement "on the record" before a judge.

These points include:

1. Get a court reporter and order the transcript
2. Have all parties and their counsel present
3. Be sure all parties have agreed on all material terms before the hearing begins to avoid a convoluted transcript
4. Use a written outline of the settlement terms before you start speaking to avoid misstating or omitting terms
5. State all material terms of the settlement and conclude by stating that there are no other material terms
6. Counsel or the court should confirm that all parties have heard the settlement terms, understand them, do not have any questions regarding the terms, and agree to be bound by the terms as stated
7. Obtain an acknowledgment from all counsel that there are no other material terms of the settlement
8. Reserve jurisdiction of court under Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 and 664.7, if applicable
9. Refer to a written settlement agreement which will be drafted incorporating these terms
10. Request court to schedule hearing in 30 – 45 days to address any "issues" which arise

They also discussed ways to enforce your settlement by filing a supplemental pleading in the underlying action, a separate action for breach of contract, or a motion to enforce settlement under Code of Civil Procedure sections 664.6. and 664.7, if your case involves a residential construction defect matter.

## CATCH THIS

The FBA Family Law Section's August 2010 brown bag lunch and learn seminar hosted the well-versed Garrison Klueck, Esq. on the top ten cases of late 2009 and 2010. This is the ninth straight year that Bud has been giving his update seminar for the Family Law section. Bud has always been supportive of our Foothills Bar Association of which he is the past president. He is an adjunct professor at two local law schools.

Bud had a short handout of the list of cases that were important in the last year. His criteria for selection included cases that involved a fundamental or significant change in the law, changes from usual custom and practice as observed in San Diego County, and/or cases which involved a San Diego County judge or the 4<sup>th</sup> District Court of Appeals.

One of the cases involved attorney fees and which we heard last month discussed by our speaker Judge Joel Wohlfeil. In Alan S., Jr v Superior Court (2009) 172 CA4th 238, the court ruled that the household or new mate's income can be considered in arriving at an attorney fees award.

Other cases included topics of child and spousal support, attorney fees, interstate custody, transmutations of community property, parental rights, the Hague convention, evidence of harassment in a DVRO case, motion for reconsideration and bankruptcy. About half of the cases cited involved specific issues in my cases.

Specifically:

1. M.S. v O.S. (2009) Cal.App.4<sup>th</sup> 548 considered whether bonuses, free housing and paid attorney fees are income.
2. Abbott v Abbott (2010) 130 S.Ct. 1983 determined that a party who has less than 50% physical custody has standing under the Hague Convention.
3. In Re Marriage of Buie and Neighbors 179 Cal.App.4<sup>th</sup> 1170 ruled that the husband's purchase of a Porsche with wife's separate monies without a writing from her did not transmute the car to him. This one sounds like interesting reading.

The FBA Family Law section greatly appreciates Bud's continued service to our bar association and to the Family Law section. Next year he says he will be proficient to be able to do a Powerpoint presentation.

By the way, former Commissioner Alan Clements, also a Foothills Bar member, attended the seminar. He was always very supportive of our bar.

Remember, the Family Law section seminars are free to FBA members, who pay only \$55 for yearly dues. Plus, you get MCLE credits for the seminars. FBA members can attend the seminars presented by the civil, criminal, and estate and probate sections at no extra charge. A bargain compared to other bar associations. The Family Law section seminars are on the third Tuesday of each month.
